Grad Bash 2020 Reminders

Qualifications to Attend:

Please remember that in order to attend Grad Bash, you must maintain a 2.0 GPA and receive ZERO level 3 referrals for the entire school year. Additionally, during 3rd OR 4th Quarter you must have no more than5 unexcused absences in any CLASS PERIOD. If you do not meet the above qualifications, you will not be allowed to attend Grab Bash and will not be issued a refund.

What to Bring/Not Bring

You may NOT bring a backpack or any other bag on the bus, this includes a purse. Food and drinks are not permitted on the bus or into Universal Studios. You may NOT bring ANY prescribed or over the counter medications on your own (including Tylenol, Advil, etc.). If you have any medication needs, you must alert Mrs. Walter of that by March 19th so she can prepare for it. You may bring a blanket and pillow for the bus ride home that must stay on the bus during the event. Anyone needing handicapped access for the bus must alert Mrs. Walter prior to March 6th so she can make arrangements with the charter bus company.

<u>Attire</u>

Universal Studios has a dress code that all students must adhere to. Any student who is not properly dressed WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to board the bus or attend the event.

GIRLS, you may wear:

Dresses/skirts/shorts that are a reasonable length (meeting Pasco County Schools Dress Code), capris, jeans, casual blouses/tops, comfortable shoes, tennis shoes, boots, and dress sandals.

GUYS, you may wear:

Jeans or shorts, shirts WITH SLEEVES, comfortable shoes (tennis shoes or boots), hats, shirts with college team names or logos.

<u>Unacceptable attire includes:</u> clothing with excessive holes or shredding, obscene/offensive language or graphics, visible undergarments, tank tops or undershirts, bikini tops, sports bras, dresses/shorts/skirts that are too short, area codes displayed on clothing, accessories with chains/spiked/studs, high school team names or logos, any type of sports jersey.

Agenda for the Night

Please remember that we are adhering to a strict timeline of events as we have a contract with the charter bus company to satisfy and traffic to the event to navigate. You are expected to adhere to the agenda below. You may NOT drive yourself to or from the event, nor may you ride in any other vehicle to or from the event except for the designated bus. Additionally, you must ride the same bus home you were on as you came to Universal.

3:30pm Arrive on campus, park in the student parking lot, get checked in with Mrs. Walter. Each student will be searched prior to boarding the bus.

4:00pm Buses depart from RRHS. WE WILL NOT WAIT FOR YOU! You must be on time or you will not be attending the event and will not receive a refund. You may NOT drive yourself to the event.

6:30pm Arrival at Universal, get tickets and bands on the bus.

7:00pm Admission to Universal Studios.

2:00am Students must be back at the buses BY 2:00am. Plan on making your way to the buses BEFORE 2:00am so you are not late.

4:00am Arrival back at RRHS. If you are not driving yourself home from the RRHS parking lot, your ride MUST be there to meet the buses.

Any student who doesn't follow the rules set forth by Universal Studios, or commits an egregious infraction of the Student Code of Conduct while at the event or in transit to/from the event, will be subject to dismissal from the event wherein a parent/guardian will have to drive to Universal Studios to retrieve the student immediately and no refund will be issued.
