Grad Bash is an exclusive event for high school seniors (there are no guests there other than seniors), and we have the following expectations of our students in order to keep everyone safe and ensure a wonderful evening.

PRICE - \$120, includes ticket and charter bus. Annual passes are not accepted, and students may not drive separately.

REQUIREMENTS – Please remember that in order to attend Grad Bash, you must:

- *Maintain a 2.0 GPA for the entire school year
- *Receive ZERO level 3 referrals for the entire school year
- *Have NO MORE THAN 10 UNEXCUSED ABSENCES IN ANY CLASS IN THE 90 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EVENT-Starting on Jan 7th.
- *Additionally, during 3rd OR 4th Quarter you may not have more than 5 unexcused absences IN ANY of your classes.

WE WILL CHECK FOR ATTENDANCE, REFERRALS AND GPA THE WEEK OF THE EVENT. If you do not meet the above qualifications, you will not be allowed to attend Grab Bash and you will **not be issued a refund**.

PAYMENT – There are two ways you can pay for Grad Bash. All payments and your permission slip must be submitted by March 9th

Paying with either of these options, reserves your spot. There are no refunds on partial payment plans for any reason.

*Full Payment of \$120 due by March 9th

*2 Payments 1st payment of \$60 due Feb 3 & 2nd payment due March 9th)

DRESS ATTIRE – CHECK BACK OF THIS FORM! Universal has a specific dress code that must be adhered to. All students will be checked for dress code compliance prior to boarding the bus.
