- ♦ 2.0 Minimum Unweighted Cumulative GPA
- ♣ No level 3 violations during current school year
- ♦ Less than 6 unexcused absences in any given period in quarters 3, or 4
- ◆ Must be on track with credits (Freshmen 3, Sophomores 9, Juniors 15, and Seniors 21

If you are off track for any of the above items, you MUST schedule an appeal. All appeals must be submitted online (MACH form) by **April 14. Appeals** will be scheduled between April 15-17. It is also the expectation that students attend all scheduled periods on May 8th. If at any time prior to prom you don't meet the above criteria, you may not be permitted to attend. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**

DRESS ATTIRE

Gentlemen Dress pants, dress shirt, tie. Tuxes are acceptable but not required. No jeans, khakis, or casual wear. Shirts will remain on all evening.
