

SENIOR PARKING LOT PAINTING INFORMATION

1. On the day of the event park in middle school parking lot or unnumbered spots in the high school parking lot.
2. **Complete the River Ridge Campus Vehicle Operation Policies and bring it** with you to painting and we will issue your parking pass.
3. Complete the Safe Behind the Wheel course if you haven't done so already.
4. Pay your Parking spot fee **AND** your "Paint Your Parking Spot" fee through Acorn <https://www.studentquickpay.com/pasco/MyAccount/Main.aspx>.
5. Spot assignments will be made based on your request in Sign up Genius. THIS DOES NOT GUARANTEE you that spot, but this will be the basis of assignment and we will try to keep you in that general vicinity.
6. Trading spots will be permitted if both parties are present and the staff member working the event approves.
7. Use only **latex, water-based liquid paint**. No latex spray paint due to the aerosols and potential overspray.
8. Any design that is deemed inappropriate or in violation of our painting rules will be painted over and **no refunds will be given**.
9. We will have restrooms open in Courtyard 4, and a water spout available in front of the theater. Please do not enter the school building to use the restrooms without sanitizing your hands outside first (we will have this available).
10. Masks are required when walking interacting upon arrival, however when you are working on your spot and social distanced from others you may remove it.
11. Any music played must be school appropriate including no explicit lyrics. Please check your playlist before playing your music.

Spot Painting Guidelines/Tips

- a. Use only **latex, water-based liquid paint**. No latex spray paint due to the aerosols and potential overspray.
- b. Tape off a border of 2-4 inches from the white parking lines as well as at the top & bottom of your spot.
- c. Do not paint the numbers located at the bottom of the spot.
- d. Do not paint wheel stops (concrete curb at the top of your spot).
- e. If you are painting a solid color background on top of the black, it typically takes a full gallon depending on the color.
- f. You must supply your own painting materials and **take all paint cans home** (we don't have the proper disposal)!
- g. We will have trash cans throughout the parking lot for personal trash only (water bottles, paper towels, food containers, etc.).
- h. Plan on bringing your own trash bags for your rollers, paint pans, brushes, etc. so you can easily transport everything back home.
- i. Strong suggestion: Put a box in your vehicle with a plastic barrier under it to prevent any spillage in/damage to your vehicle. Only materials used to paint (not including paint cans) may be thrown away.
- i. We ask that students only have one other person at their spot with them to help with social distancing. Please be smart about this and respect those around you. Parents are more than welcome to come and help, however, we ask that only one comes at a time.
- j. It's a good idea to bring paper towels, baby wipes, something to kneel/sit on when you paint, and a broom to sweep off your spot.
- k. Please bring plenty of water and sunscreen☺
- l. Small pop up tents may be brought, but be careful to not impede the painting of those around you as well as not blocking the path for a golf cart to be able to get through the parking lot.
