



## NAHS Bylaws

To remain a member in good standing, all NAHS members must pay their dues and complete 8 service points in the visual arts each year.

Annual dues of \$5.00 will be collected at the beginning of the year from each member.

Attendance is required at all meetings to maintain membership and privileges. NAHS members are allowed to miss only one meeting per grading period. Reasonable absences will be allowed with a signed note from the member's parents.

NAHS members must participate in club projects and service activities throughout the year.

Service hours can be earned through various opportunities, such as:

- Volunteering and visiting county art shows, such as the Pasco County Fair, FL State Fair, etc. Students who visit a county art show must not have artwork featured in the exhibit and must also submit a written report of their experience with photos. (1pt per hour)
- Volunteering/Participating in various Charity Events (1pt per hour)
- Volunteering at art summer camps (1pt per hour)
- End of year art room clean-up (1pt per hour)
- Attending NAHS meetings (1pt per meeting)
- Every NAHS member is required to submit at least one original artwork to the RRHS literary magazine (2 pts per piece)

NAHS officers must attend executive meetings called outside of the regularly scheduled member meetings.

All members must maintain a 3.0 weighted GPA.

To graduate with NAHS honors and earn the right to wear a NAHS cord, members must remain in good academic and disciplinary standing up to the graduation date.

All NAHS members must show an avid interest in the visual arts and be dedicated to their arts education.

NAHS applicants must have 1 full completed high school art credit before they can apply.

Violations of RRHS rules will not be excused or accepted by new applicants or existing members. Disciplinary referrals and out of school suspensions may result in expulsion from the National Art Honor Society.

In the event of any infraction of these bylaws, a review by the officers and teacher sponsors will be conducted. If the individual in question is an officer, he/she will not participate in the decision-making process.
