



Summer 2026 Dual Enrollment Online Registration and Course Request Worksheet

Dear Parent/Legal Guardian:

Pasco-Hernando State College (PHSC) utilizes an online Dual Enrollment (DE) application/registration process. This process is now open to all eligible students.

The Summer process is as follows:

1. New Dual Enrollment students complete an online application at: <https://apply.phsc.edu/apply/>
 - a. The deadline for the application is **May 3, 2026**.
2. Eligible students complete this DE Course Request Planning Worksheet (bottom) and meet with their High School Counselor priority deadline **March 27, 2026**. Students and parents must log-in to digitally sign the Terms and Conditions online and enter the courses from their Course Request Planning Worksheet. Access to the Terms and Conditions and the Online Dual Enrollment Request Form is available via the PHSC website: <https://accelerated.phsc.edu/dual-enrollment/public-charter>
3. High School Counselors approve or deny the requests **April 10, 2026**.
4. Students will receive email notification from a PHSC Academic Advisor of approved/denied DE courses by **April 24, 2026**. This email will be sent to each student's PHSC email address.
5. Students must still register through their PHSC student portal/Banner, on the following dates and times below, for approved courses.

The deadlines indicated above must be met to access online registration during the dates and times outlined below. Students who do not meet deadlines may experience a delay in the registration process beyond the initial registration window.
