To keep everyone safe and ensure a wonderful evening, we have the following expectations for all students and guests attending our dance.

DRESS CODE:

Young Men: Semi-formal is encouraged, though formal dress is acceptable. Ties are encouraged. Shirts will remain on all evening, or you will be asked to leave. The principal's/designee's decision is FINAL.

Young Women: Semi-formal is encouraged, though formal dress is acceptable, including dresses, pants, suits, or gowns appropriately covering the chest and in good taste. Comfortable shoes are encouraged as dancing will be on gym floor. Attire must be at least school-appropriate length and must stay down when walking or dancing or you will be asked to leave.

Everyone: Students dressed inappropriately will be turned away at the door. Students will not be admitted wearing cargo pants, sneakers, jeans/denim, t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts, hats and head coverings, bandanas, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products. The principal's/designee's decision is FINAL.

***We will NOT have a shoe/purse check-in at the dance. Please do not bring valuables into the event.**

DANCE EXPECTATIONS:

- Face-to-face preferred but not mandatory. Front to back acceptable with no bending over.
- No grinding or "freak" dancing.
- No inappropriate touching – hands on waist or shoulders only.
- No "making out" or overt and/or prolonged public displays of affection.
- The dance policy allows an RRHS student to bring only one guest.
- If too many couples are dancing inappropriately, the lights will be turned on and/or music changed as a collective warning for everyone.

Students:

In order to attend the dance, you must meet the following criteria. No refunds will be issued if your status changes after you have purchased a ticket. Please verify this information before purchasing a ticket.

- You must have a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA
- Not have any level 3 referrals this year or level 2 referrals that resulted in OSS.
- **No more than 5 unexcused absences in any period.**

Dance Ticket Sales: Sept. 1st – Sept. 13th for \$40

Sept. 14th – Sept. 16th for \$45

Ticket Pick up: Sept. 7th – Sept. 16th in cafeteria

Tickets can be picked up ONLY during lunch A and B in the cafeteria. and this permission slip to cafeteria during lunch to receive a paper homecoming ticket. To pay in person by cash or check, bring payment and completed permission slip to cafeteria during lunch to receive a paper ticket.

Be sure you are eligible before purchasing a ticket based on the criteria above. Refunds will not be granted if your eligibility status changes after you purchase a ticket.

After reading the above, I understand that I will dress and behave appropriately at our homecoming dance and abide by all the school rules.
